This event welcomes 1,000+ high school students and educators from 100+ schools and youth organizations across Colorado, and will feature two workshop sessions on the day of the conference, which takes place on **Saturday**, **February 1**, **2025** and will be hosted by Cherry Creek High School.

Presenters will need to arrive on the CCHS campus no later than 10:30am for registration. The first workshop session will run from 12:10 – 1:20pm; the second workshop session will run from 1:30 – 2:40pm. Each workshop will include a mixture of 20–30 students and adults from various schools across the state.
