Who We Are

Youth Celebrate Diversity (YCD) is a youth-led leadership and activism training program, where students ages 11-18 can build community, develop their identity and self-confidence, learn critical skills for advocacy and changemaking, and ignite a passion for advancing inclusion and justice in our communities. Our vision is that one day, every teen in America will feel safe, respected, and empowered to achieve their potential.

YCD organizes its work through chapters, which are youth-led spaces that leverage YCD's training and curriculum to bring students together for inclusion and justice. Each chapter is led by 2+ youth leaders and advised by 2 adult mentors.

YCD is the proud recipient of the 2018 Colorado Governor's Service Award for Outstanding Nonprofit Organization and the 2021 Inclusiveness@Work Nonprofit Award.

All proceeds from The Changemakers Gala will support YCD in sustaining its in-person programs and chapters in Colorado and New Mexico, while also strengthening our youth-led virtual training and education curriculum centered on diversity, inclusion, equity, and social justice that can be used by any middle or high school student or club in the United States.

Keynote Speaker

Soledad O'Brien



Soledad O'Brien is an award-winning documentarian, journalist, speaker, author, philanthropist, and founder of Soledad O'Brien Productions, a media production company dedicated to telling empowering and authentic stories on a range of social issues. She anchors and produces "Matter of Fact with Soledad O'Brien," a Hearst political magazine program seen in 95% of the country. She was inducted into the Broadcasting and Cable Hall of Fame in May 2023. She has made a name in podcasting, co-hosting the top-rated series "Who Killed JFK" with Rob Reiner for IHeart, reporting the Luminary series "Murder on the Towpath," and hosting "Growing up POC" on Audible, "Very Opinionated" on Quake, and "Everyday Wealth" for Edelman Financial.

Soledad has a national impact through her op-eds, social media, speeches, and books, including her critically acclaimed memoir "The Next Big Story" and 1.3 million X followers. She gave Congressional testimony on media disinformation. She has anchored shows and

specials on CNN, MSNBC, Nat Geo, BET, ABC, and CBS, co-anchored NBC's Weekend Today, and reported for PBS NewsHour and HBO Real Sports.

Her most recent project is her documentary "The End of Affirmative Action" which streamed on CBS, Paramount +, and YouTube. She is Executive Producer of the Peabody-Award-winning documentary, "The Rebellious Life of Rosa Parks" which premiered at the Tribeca Film Festival and streams on Peacock, and the multi-part series "Black and Missing", which won the Independent Spirit and NAACP awards and streams on HBO. Soledad O' Brien Productions has also produced documentaries for Discovery Plus, CNN, BET, PBS, and others.

O'Brien's work has been recognized with four Emmy awards, three times with the George Foster Peabody Award, four times with the Gracie Award, which honors women in media, twice with Cine Awards for her work in documentary films, twice with Telly Awards and with an Alfred I. DuPont Award.

She runs the PowHerful foundation with her husband which has helped dozens of young women get to and through college and connects thousands of others with assistance through regional mentoring conferences.
